## Summary of ECD Global Alliance chat held on Saturday 6th August 2011

## 10 Present

- Before the Chat started, a member had posted a long piece in support of the ECD Global Alliance. It was pointed out that the Global Alliance is the only organization known in the world dedicated completely to ECD, and that the Global Alliance has done more for ECD research and support than any other organization.
- There was considerable interest in the, recently announced, NIH study at Bethesda. A number of members said that they would like to be involved. The first necessary step is to contact the study team. Kathy has offered to make an e-mail introduction of members to Dr Estrada-Veras, so that he can then make direct e-mail contact. - The NIH holds a lot of information about travel possibilities and would be a source for members travelling.
- It was suggested by a number of people that Washington is definitely worth a visit while you are there.
- Members were reminded about the current fund-raising activity. It was suggested that notifying friends, that use Facebook, is a good method of raising contributions.
- A member continues to have a lot of difficulty due to fluid seeping from her legs. Compression hose have not solved the problem so far and the skin is irritated.
- A 3 day hospital stay, steroids and a blood transfusion allowed one member to dance out of hospital! He had been too ill to even walk in!
- One member is seeing a doctor shortly about pains in his back. He thinks that injection treatments will be suggested. Another member said that a parent had had back trouble, and found that the injections were a good treatment.

- It was pointed out that the GA may well be able to help out where it is problematic to send the large volume of records (that we all have!!) to researchers. Please contact Kathy about this.
- It was agreed that it was too hot EVERYWHERE. 2 members talked about cruising from the US to Norway (where another member "happens" to live!).
