The introduction of 5 new ECD Referral Care Centers in 4 different countries. Cross-specialty medical teams at ECD Referral Care Centers are committed to treating ECD patients and learning more about the disease. The hospital network facilitates collaboration and knowledge sharing with other institutions to improve patient outcomes.

10 new languages added to the ECD Global Alliance website. Resources are now available in Spanish, French, German, Dutch, Italian, Portuguese, Hebrew, Greek, Norwegian, and Chinese thanks in large part to our kindhearted volunteers.

The ECD Patient Registry development is underway. Registry data entry is scheduled for this fall once construction of the patient-centric database is completed. Global ECD researchers will have the opportunity to use collected and consolidated data to better understand and develop effective therapies for ECD sufferers. The one and only registry focused on furthering ECD research facilitates open sharing of data worldwide.

Three new research studies have started focusing on a variety of ECD issues. Research includes the understanding of neurological and cognitive issues associated with ECD, genetic mutations in ECD sufferers for better treatment options, and how malignant cells accumulate and interact with healthy cells to fuel the disease.
